

SMALL GATHERING GUIDELINES

EFFECTIVE 09/04/2020 5PM



EXECUTIVE ORDER

All individuals present need to acknowledge the executive order requirements and agree to submit to them.

- ◆ Stay within the limits of the current Executive Order issued by the Governor regarding gathering size:
 - ◆ We are currently under the Executive Order for Phase 2.5 Reopening. This limits indoor gatherings to no more than 25 people and the maintaining of at least 6-feet of social distancing. The limits for outdoor gatherings are no more than 50 individuals while maintaining at least 6-feet of social distancing.
 - ◆ Childcare should not be offered. Children in attendance count against the total number of individuals for the gathering and parents are expected to help their children maintain social distancing requirements.



FACE MASKS

- ◆ In accordance with health directives and Executive Order, face masks should be worn.



COVID-19 POSITIVE

- ◆ If anyone has had a positive COVID-19 test within the past 14 days they should not attend.

COVID-19 EXPOSURE

- ◆ If anyone has had known contact with a COVID-19 positive individual within the past 14 days they should not attend.

COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- ◆ Individuals who have had symptoms such as cough, fever, shortness of breath, vomiting, or diarrhea in the past 3 days should not attend.



CONTACT TRACING

- ◆ A list should be maintained of individuals who attend the gathering to facilitate contact tracing should someone in attendance test positive for COVID-19 within the next 14 days.



TRAVEL

- ◆ Individuals who have traveled outside the US or to a “hot spot” state within the US in the past two weeks should not attend.

All persons in attendance must also acknowledge that First Presbyterian Church is not responsible for any illness contracted during a social gathering.
