In all they did and all they said to people everywhere.

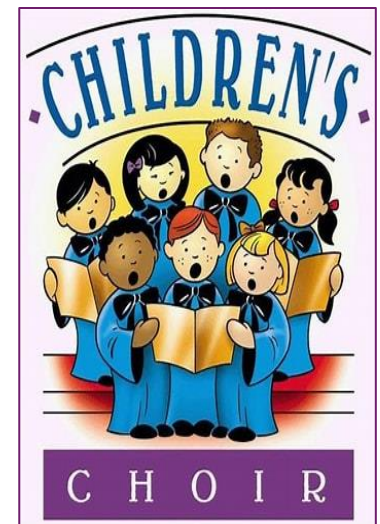
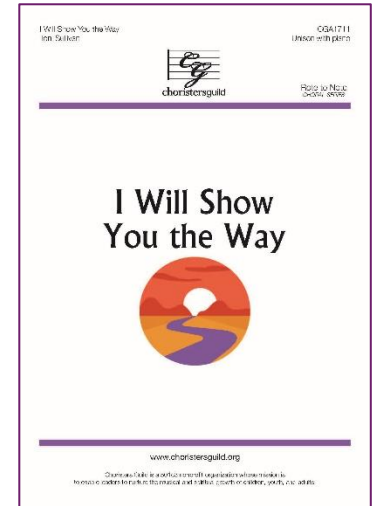
