


Why Short-term Mission Trips?

Community outreach

o The Cielo Cooperative is a women's ministry of artisans creating products to support their families and community through their sales. Part of their ministry is to deliver "blessings" of food and supplies to families in need. Americans and Dominicans work together to visit the families, delivering food and praying for them

Church service

 The Evangelical Church of Cielo meets close to Mission Emanuel. We will attend the bi-lingual service either Sunday morning and/or Wednesday night.

Where do we stay?

The Dominican Fiesta Hotel in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic (Capitol City).

Mission Emanuel is located in the neighborhood of Cielo in Bayona, Santo Domingo West.





What about food/water safety?

All water is at the mission is supplied by Mission Emanuel's water purification plant, Provisión del Cielo.

Food is provided either at the hotel, at the Mission, or at local restaurants.





What does a day's schedule look like?

- 7 AM: Breakfast at hotel/morning devotional time
- 10 AM (Sun only): Church service in Cielo
- 9 AM -12:15 PM: Work projects in Cielo
- 12:30 PM: Lunch in Cielo
- 1:30-3:30 PM: Continue work projects/community time
- 4-5:30 PM: Free/rest/swim time at the hotel
- 5-7 PM (night varies): Walking tour of Historic Santo Domingo and dinner
- 6:00 PM: Dinner at local restaurant or at the mission
- 8:00 PM (Weds only): Church service
- 8:00 PM Team meetings with time to share "God sightings"

Who can go?

- Adults
- Families, including children and youth. Middle schoolers may not go without parents.
- How young may children be? Mission Emanuel suggests "no diapers, no naps; flexible attitude."
- High school students (with or without families)
- Limit = 60 people

How much does it cost?

Prices below include hotel stay, food, ground transportation, and operational costs while in the DR (not airfare). There is a max room capacity of 3 people over the age of 12 (high school students going without parents pay the triple cost).

Triple - \$1145*

Double - \$1155*

Single - \$1485* (*2025 prices. 2026 prices may be different)

Airfare / Arrival

- Adult and families: Book travel on your own (but team will be sharing helpful flight information with each other)
- High School student w/o families: contact Amy or Emory to book flights with other participants
- Arrive June 6 between 12-5pm

- Departure: hotel check out is 12pm (ME staff will take you to the airport 3 hours early, plus 45 minute bus ride)
