## "Hymns For a Lifetime"

You have been challenged to memorize 2 verses of 20 hymns this year. (1 verse for grades K-2) You will have a set group of hymns in a prescribed order. Everyone interested in participating has received a packet of hymns to take home for practice. There may be a few more available. Please ask Mary Gonzales for another copy if you're unable to find yours. You can also use your own hymnal if you have one. Remember that this is a completely voluntary activity. No one is required to participate.

Choristers will be able to pass off hymns **every Wednesday** starting on January 15, 2025. You can sing hymns alone or with a friend.

After "passing off" 10 hymns you will receive a silver "Hymns for a Lifetime" ribbon. After "passing off" 20 hymns you will receive a gold "Hymns for a Lifetime" ribbon.

We will be singing the hymns more often in choir rehearsals.


